### TerraFirm Awarded Tuttle Creek Stilling Basin Repair

TerraFirm Constuction, LLC, (TerraFirm) working as a subcontractor to BCI Construction USA, Inc., has been awarded a contract to furnish and install (34) rock anchors for the USACE's Tuttle Creek Spillway Repair Project. The overall project, located in Manhattan, Kansas, will take approximately 24 months to complete and aims to structurally strengthen the Stilling Basin wall system and address permanent repairs to a sink hole that developed in this area in the summer of 2015. TerraFirm's portion of the project includes drilling anchor holes and rock anchors, as well as design, and water proofing of the anchor holes, testing and tensioning, and the installation of bear plate grout pads. TerraFirm's work is scheduled to begin in March 2018 and will take approximately 6 months to complete.
